
incredible suite of event partners we are truly a 52 weeks a year operation. And we wouldn't want it any other way!

CLIMATE CONSCIOUS EVENTS UPDATE



Three months ago, the Sydney Showground team, together with climate solutions organisation Clima, launched the Climate Conscious Events initiative, offering our clients a seamless, end-toend service to measure, reduce, and report on the environmental impact of their events held here at Sydney Showground.

We've had an incredible response, with clients from a wide range of events working closely with our team to review their carbon emissions (CO2-e).

This initiative goes beyond simple event calculators, with the goal to prioritise reducing event emissions - So far resulting in:

- 23 emission reduction strategies
- 20 guick environmental wins
- 9 new initiatives implemented by Sydney Showground to help clients reduce their event footprint

We are proud to be setting the standard for the event industry and look forward to supporting our clients with the advent of Australia's new mandatory climate reporting rules which are set to take effect from January 2025.
